Know that the function of your leadership team affects the overall ministry
Understand the significance of teaching and training to increase leadership effectiveness
Gain additional insight on methods of teaching and training church leadership teams

Know the biblical view of women in ministry
Understand how to overcome the challenges of women in ministry and embrace one another in our accomplishments
Develop the skills to encourage the development of women in ministry

Church Administration

Know the importance of effective church administration
Acquire knowledge and resources unique to church administration
Discuss federal regulations that pertain to the church

Church Security (Ministry of Defense – M.O.D.)

Know the importance of maintaining a secure church facility
Gain intelligence that will better equip you to deal with the security issues churches face on a weekly basis
Develop tools to increase effectiveness and gain the upper hand against those who desire to victimize the church and its people

Know the importance of ministering to children as ordained by Christ
Be able to guide children's ministry to new creative heights to plan effective and relevant children's ministries
Strengthen the skills of children's ministry teachers to capture the attention of children and instill biblical concepts

Identify new areas of need in the local communities for ministry

Sacred Arts Ministry

Know the role of the sacred arts ministries in the church body
Understand the effectiveness of the sacred arts in touching heart and soul of the body
Gain tools that will help implement, improve, and empower the sacred arts ministries

Spiritual Warfare

Know the biblical foundation for resisting, overcoming, and defeating the enemy
Understand the need to be equipped to combat the spiritual attacks against individuals and the church
Identify methods to identify the enemy's weapons and thus tear down strongholds
